


8-Port Fast Ethernet Switch

Description:

The 10/100Mbps Fast Ethernet Switch is designed to provide switching technology at Fast Ethernet speeds. It enables users to share printers, files and access to the high speed network services such as DSL or ISDN within the home or office. The Switches provide plug-and-play installation and a user-friendly design with LEDs to indicate power, Link/Activity and 100Mbps. In addition, the auto MDIX function allows Switch to auto-detect uplink to easily cascade additional hubs, switches and routers from any port.

Installation: (see Fig.1)

- 1. Place the module horizontally.
- 2. Push the module so the hook and tabs will fall into the rail slots of the enclosure.
- 3. Slide the module LEFT and the spring fastener will automatically lock the module at the desired position.



Setup the network

To establish the network connections, these ports require Category 5 or higher level patch cords. Connect one end of the patch cord to individual workstation, server or other Ethernet device; connect the other end to any port of the Switch. (See Fig.2)



Note - Maximum 100 meters per port Hub-to-Hub or Node-to-Hub cable length.

Note - Connect the AC/DC adapter 5VDC, 600mA provided to proper power source.

Option-There is also a DC power cord provided. Connect one end to the Switch and the other end to DC Power Module.

Auto MDIX (Auto Cross Over)

The "Auto Cross Over" means that the port(s) can automatically establish the link with other hub/switch or Ethernet adapters over either straight through or cross over Cat. 5 cable. It is convenient to easily setup the network, even on port expansion.
